CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
July 19, 2016**

The City Council of the City of Greenfield, Minnesota, met in regular session on Tuesday, July 19, 2016, at 7:00 p.m. in the council chambers at 6390 Town Hall Drive.

4. Approve agenda

MOTION by Cook, seconded by Hoekstra to approve the agenda. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

5. Public Comment/Response to Public Comment

Carol Beasecker, 6255 North Shore Drive, stated that at 10:30 p.m. she heard a large bang and it was the heating up of the tar to do the crack sealing. She questioned if 70 degrees is warm enough for this process and wanted Council to be aware of that activity.

Mayor Johnson responded to a previous comment about Emergency Management response when a tree fell across the road during a storm, and who citizens should call. Hennepin County Sheriff's Department is the lead agency for our Emergency Management and Public Safety. Citizens should call 911 which will dispatch Hennepin County and Fire Department(s) if need be. Hennepin County has the cell phone numbers of the City Administrator and Public Works Supervisor if needed.

Johnson also responded to a comment about the condition of the seal coating. This concern was addressed by the Council with the contractor at a previous meeting. Adhesion was the problem, and it was an issue for the contractor in other cities also.

7. Discussion/Action Items

A. City employees serving as members of the Fire Department

Ritter stated that at a previous meeting it was reported that the Rockford Fire Department has reviewed the option of establishing an Emergency Medical Responders (EMR's) team that would help with medical calls that have been proven to be an issue with response times during the work day hours. There are City employees who have expressed an interest in joining the Rockford Fire Department in this capacity.

MOTION by Cook, seconded by Erickson to allow City employees to remain on the clock when responding as Emergency Medical Responders (EMR's) with the Fire Department during the employees' regular work day hours. All voted in favor. Motion carried.

B. Floodplain Ordinance Amendment

According to the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), the City is required to, as a condition of continued eligibility in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP), adopt or show evidence of adoption of floodplain management regulations that meet the standards of NFIP regulations.

MOTION by Erickson, seconded by Holten to refer the floodplain ordinance to the Planning Commission for public hearing and recommendation to the Council. All voted in favor. Motion carried.
