

**CITY OF GREENFIELD
REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
May 05, 2020**

The City Council of the City of Greenfield, Minnesota, met in regular session on Tuesday, May 05, 2020, at 7:00 p.m. in the Council Chambers at 7738 Commerce Circle.

1. Call Meeting to Order

MOTION by Jeska, Seconded by Workcuff to approve agenda.

MOTION by Klawitter, seconded by Erickson to move 6. E. from the Consent Agenda to Discussion/Action Item 8. A. All voted in favor of the amendment. Motion carried 5-0. All voted in favor approving the agenda. Motion carried 5-0.

9. Information/Miscellaneous

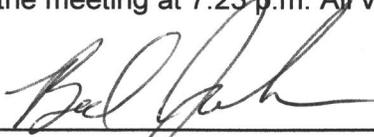
A. Comments/reports from Mayor. Mayor said Lakefield City Council took a stand to not support the Governor's executive orders.
