
A. Comments/reports from Mayor. None.

B. Comments/reports from Councilors. Jeska none. Erickson none. Klawitter stated the internet survey is ready to print and he will refer to Staff for project timing. Workcuff and Klawitter attended the water shed meeting. Workcuff stated Greenfield's annual membership assessment fee for 2021 is increasing over 15% due to the large property value increase by Hennepin County. He also stated that the watershed has grants available for projects. Johnson asked Staff to check the numbers as they do not match the information that the Hennepin County Assessors provided to Council. Workcuff received a resident complaint about people feeding the geese on North Shore Drive. Feeding the geese increases the geese population and waste. Staff is directed to check with other cities and the City Attorney to see if they have ordinances on feeding non-domestic wildlife.

C. Comments/reports from City Administrator/Staff. Staff sated the internet survey postcards are being printed and will be mailed out on Thursday. Veolia and the MN Dept. of Health provided positive results for the last radium sample tests. Council asked if a letter could go out to let the residents know that the filter media improvement had a positive input on the numbers. Staff will work with Veolia to draft a letter. There will be a workshop at 6 p.m. June 16 to discuss 2021 road projects.
