1. **Call Meeting to Order**
2. **Roll Call** – Mayor Johnson, Councilors Bronczyk, Klawitter, Roehl, Workcuff

3. **Closed Session pursuant to MN Stat. 13D.05 subd. 3(c)(3)** to discuss offers or counteroffers related to the real property located at 7850 State Highway 55, Greenfield, MN (PID: 28-119-24-33-0009). MOTION by Klawitter, seconded by Roehl to go into closed session. Motion carried 5-0. MOTION by Roehl, seconded by Klawitter to close the closed session. Motion carried 5-0. Attorney Thames noted Council adjourned a closed session. Attorney and Staff have direction.
4. **Gravel Roads Maintenance** (Kris Menth Public Works Supervisor and Ron Wagner City Engineer will be in attendance) Wagner discussed details on paved roads vs gravel roads. Menth gave deep education on the gravel road maintenance and processes. Roehl said shouldering and poor crown is a problem. Johnson said no one is neglecting our gravel roads, traffic is the cause. Klawitter doesn't feel council or staff are neglecting the roads, staff is doing a good job. We will have to continue to invest in the gravel roads. Bronczyk said design capacity has exceeded the gravel roads and they won't stand the wear. Staff is doing a great job on our roads. Workcuff said staff is doing a good job on roads. Improvements can be made but he is not here to criticize and let professionals do their job. Driving behavior is the cause. Johnson encouraged staff to continue networking with neighboring public works on processes and improvements. Roehl stated gravel roads are worth doing better.
