- * Mail, office and school papers
- * Magazines and catalogs
- * Newspapers and inserts
- * Phone books
- * Shredded paper in closed paper bags



Boxes:

- * Cardboard
- * Cereal and cracker boxes
- * Shoe boxes, gift boxes and electronics boxes
- * Toothpaste, medication and other toiletry boxes



CARTONS

- * Milk cartons
- * Juice boxes
- * Soup, broth and wine cartons

GLASS

- * Food and beverage bottle and jars



PLASTIC

Bottles & Jugs

- * Water, soda and juice bottles
- * Milk and juice jugs
- * Ketchup and salad dressing bottles
- * Dishwashing liquid bottles and detergent jugs
- * Shampoo, soap and lotion bottles



Cups & Containers

- * Yogurt, pudding and fruit cups
- * Disposable cups and bowls
- * Margarine, cottage cheese and other containers
- * Produce, deli and take-out containers

Packaging

- * Clear packaging from toys and electronics

METAL

- * Food and beverage cans

BROOKLYN PARK Transfer Station and Recycling Center—Full and self service areas

BLOOMINGTON - South Hennepin Recycling and Problem Waste Drop-off Center—Full service only - 1400 W 96th St, Bloomington, MN 55431

Bring proof of residency, such as a driver's license or utility bill and payment, if applicable—cash, check or credit card

Acceptable items: Organics; Needles and Sharps; Recycling; Cardboard; Cords and Lights; Tires; Scrap Metal; Mattresses and Box Springs; Appliances; Gas-powered Appliances; Household Hazardous Materials, Lawn, Garden, Automotive; Electronics; Batteries; Media and Propane/Gas Cylinders.



Un-accepted items: Ammunition; Asbestos; Business Hazardous Waste; Carpet; Concrete; Asphalt; Construction Materials; Empty Gas Cans; Explosives; Furniture; Garbage; Medicines; Radioactive Waste; Remodeling Debris; Treated Wood and Yard/Tree Waste.
