




The City of Greenfield wants to make your voting experience as easy as possible this election. Our City Hall is open Monday—Thursday from 7am—5:30 pm for Absentee Voting. Starting October 27th Direct Balloting begins and you are able to place your ballot into the ballot counter until Monday November 2nd at 5pm. City Hall will be open on Saturday, October 31st from 10am—3pm for voting. On election day the polls open at 7am and close at 8pm. If you have received your absentee ballots in the mail already and do not want to mail them in—just drop them off at city hall and we will courier them over to Hennepin County for you!

The City of Greenfield invested in a large tent to help voters stay warm while waiting in line to vote while maintaining social distancing. We are also all set up for Curb Side Voting! Just Drive up, Call the number on the sign and we will come out to you to vote! As easy as that!



The City of Greenfield will be taking Covid19 very seriously and will be following all safety guidelines for disinfecting and social distancing. Masks will be provided for you if you do not have one. If you do not bring a pen to vote, a new sanitized pen will be given to each voter.
